

Board of Directors Job Description and Expectations

CCS Purpose: To provide support to families and individuals in need by providing assistance and linking them with resources that will enable them to become healthier in mind, body, and spirit.

CCS Objectives:

- 1. Provide food to meet the short-term needs of hungry people.
- 2. Provide clothing and personal care items of families.
- 3. Provide opportunities and resources that will teach people how to create their own healthy and balanced lifestyle.
- 4. Provide opportunities and resources for medical care.

Board Authority: The management of the affairs and business of Clive Community Services shall be vested in a Board of Directors.

Elections: Board member positions are filled by invitation to those in the community that are in agreement with the purpose and objectives of Clive Community Services.

Terms: Board members serve two year terms and may be elected for consecutive terms.

Functions: The Board of Directors shall determine the policy and manage the property and affairs of the organization to fulfill the purpose and objectives.

Meetings: Meetings take place the second Wednesday of February, April, June, August, October and December at 11:30 AM at Middendorf Insurance in Clive. A quorum of four members must be present to have an official meeting and make decisions.

Attendance: Members are expected to attend at least fifty percent of regularly scheduled meetings. Absences must be communicated to a board officer. Members can be removed for absence according to the bylaws. Our board members are working board members, participating in the organization's activities or committees.
